Through the Partners in Education program, CHA residents are able to attend City Colleges of Chicago at low or no cost. Residents who are enrolled at a four-year institution during the academic year can take up to two courses at no cost over the summer, with tuition and books covered through Partners in Education. Those credits can then be transferred to their year-round institution.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible, students must:

- Be a current CHA resident and a college student
- Have no previous debt with City Colleges of Chicago
- Meet with your academic advisor at your four-year institution to ensure courses from City Colleges of Chicago will transfer to support your degree completion
- Register for and attend an information session before May 7, 2025
