Hilliard Homes is a mixed-income development with 117 family CHA units in Chicago's Near South community. It includes four residential structures and a community building. Designed by Bertrand Goldberg (Marina Towers, River City), Hilliard was built in 1966 and placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1999. The \$98 million historic preservation of Hilliard was completed in 2007. Hilliard was awarded the 2007 National Trust/HUD Secretary's Award for Excellence in Historic Preservation.
