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CHA Moves May 17, 2022 Board of Commissioners Meeting from In-Person to Virtual

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CHICAGO (May 16, 2022): The Chicago Housing Authority announced today that its Board of Commissioners meeting scheduled for tomorrow, Tuesday, May 17, 2022 is being moved from an inperson to virtual format.

The move comes after CHA CEO Tracey Scott tested positive for Covid-19 over the weekend. Scott began experiencing symptoms late last week and has been in isolation per CDC guidelines.
