Chicago's Coordinated Entry System

The **Coordinated Entry System** (CES) connects people who are experiencing homelessness to housing opportunities in Chicago. Access Points provide Coordinated Entry Assessments and updates on a walk-in basis. To get help quickly, visit a CES Access Point (see list below), call 3-1-1 or call the **The Phone Access Point** at 312.971.4178. Hours are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, & Friday: 10:00 AM – 3:00 PM, and Tuesdays: 4:00 – 9:00 PM.
